**WIZARDS TIDBITS**

-Tonight's game is the first of four meetings between the Washington Wizards and Toronto Raptors. The Raptors won the season series last season, 2-1.

-Last game versus Chicago...The Wizards fell to the Chicago Bulls, 103-96, on November 13th at the United Center...Gilbert Arenas scored a season-high 30 points on 11-of-22 from the field and 7-of-10 from three-point range...John Wall scored 16 points and had six assists...Hilton Armstrong scored eight points and grabbed a season-high 10 rebounds...Nick Young added 11 points...The Bulls were led by Derrick Rose who had 24 points.

-The Wizards have totaled 103 assists in their last four games (26-11/5 vs. CLE, 25-11/10 vs. HOU, 27-11/12 vs. CHA, 25-11/13 vs. CHI). The last time the Wizards had 25 or more assists in four straight games was March 3-8 of the 2001-02 season.

-In Saturday's game in Chicago, the Wizards scored a season-high 56 bench points. This marks the most bench points scored by the Wizards since December 9, 2008 versus the Pistons. In that game the Wizards scored 59 bench points in a 107-94 win.

-Washington's 38 fourth quarter points versus the Bulls marked the most points they have scored in the fourth quarter since scoring 39 points on March 29, 2009 in Indiana.

-Gilbert Arenas became the first NBA player to score at least 30 points and hit seven three-pointers off of the bench since Roddy Beaubois of the Mavericks. Beaubois scored 40 points and nailed nine three pointers on March 27, 2010. The last Wizard to score 30 points off of the bench was Andray Blatche. Blatche did it on October 31, 2009 in a 123-104 victory over the Nets.

-Arenas scored 30 points in a game for the first time since December 28, 2009 in Memphis versus the Grizzlies.

-The last time Arenas hit seven three-pointers in a game was January 15, 2007 versus Utah. In that contest, Arenas scored 51 points and went 7-of-12 from three-point range, which included the game-winning three-pointer as time expired to give the Wizards a 114-111 victory over the Jazz.

## WIZARDS NOTES

**WALL WATCHERS:** Only eight games into his NBA career, John Wall has quickly etched his name into the NBA record book. Below are a few of Wall's eye popping feats (source-Elias Sports Bureau).

*-Is the first rookie since Oscar Robertson to have at least seven assists in each of his first six career games. Roberston recorded seven or more assists in his first 10 career games during the 1960-61 season.*

*-Joins Robertson as the only two rookies in NBA history to average a double-double with points and assists through their first six career games.*

*-Is the first player in NBA history to average a double-double with points and assists and also three steals in his first seven career games.*

*-Became the sixth fastest rookie to record a triple double.*

*-Joins Magic Johnson as the only two rookies to record a triple-double and have six steals in the same game within their first six career games.*

**TO BE CONTINUED:** After averaging 22.1 points and 8.3 rebounds during the final 32 games of the 2009-10 season, Andray Blatche is picking up where he left off. Through the first eight games, Blatche is averaging career-highs in points (16.4 ppg), rebounds (8.1 rpg) and free-throw percentage (.929). Blatche has scored 20 or more points in four contests and has posted two double-doubles.

**VETERAN PRESENCE:** Another addition to the 2010-11 Wizards roster, Kirk Hinrich, comes from the Chicago Bulls with 514 games of experience and career averages of 13.4 points and 5.8 assists per game. The seven-year pro left the Bulls as the franchise's all-time leader with 812 three-point field goals made. In eight games for the Wizards, Hinrich is averaging 11.0 points and 4.6 assists. Hinrich is currently 10 points shy of 7,000 career points.

**CLASS REUNION:** The Wizards roster features three players who were drafted in the first 16 picks of the 2007 NBA Draft: Yi Jianlian (6<sup>th</sup> overall), Al Thornton (14<sup>th</sup> overall) and Nick Young (16<sup>th</sup> overall). Among all 60 players, Thornton currently ranks fourth in career scoring average of players who were drafted in 2007.

**MCGEE'S PRODUCTION:** With increased playing time last season after the All-Star break, came increased production from Wizards center JaVale McGee. McGee's scoring, rebounding and blocks per game averages increased from 2.2 ppg, 1.3 rpg and 1.1 bpg prior to the All-Star break to 10.1 ppg, 6.5 rpg and 2.2 bpg following the All-Star break. On April 6, 2010 versus Golden State, McGee turned in a career performance with a career-high 25 points and a career-high 15 rebounds. The seven-footer became the first NBA player to record at least 25 points and 15 rebounds in less than 31 minutes off of the bench since Kevin McHale scored 25 points, 16 rebounds in 28 minutes on December 14, 1984.

**YI IN DC:** In a trade with the New Jersey Nets in June, the Wizards acquired former 2007 lottery pick Yi Jianlian. Jianlian averaged a career-high of 12.0 points and 7.2 rebounds for the Nets last season. The native of China put on an impressive performance for his country in the 2010 FIBA World Championships. Yi finished fifth in scoring in the tournament with 20.2 points per game and first in rebounding with 10.2 rebounds per game in six games.
